Client Demographics

Age, ethnicity/race & gender clearly indicated

Locate/Identify HIV+ and High Risk Individuals

EIS workers locate/identify HIV+ and high-risk persons not in care

Needs Assessment

Assessment for immediate needs to help bring a client into care

Risk Behavior Assessment

Risk behavior assessment to identify risk factors

Documentation of Transmission prevention/education

Documentation of HIV results

Engagement/Re-engagement

EIS workers (re)engagement into HIV care and case management, offer appointment reminders, accompany clients on PC/CM appointments

Education/Support

EIS workers will provide health education and literacy training that enable clients to navigate the HIV system of care

Client Follow-up

EIS workers refer clients to appropriate support services and follow-up with clients & referral agencies regarding linkages.

Provider Communication

EIS workers communicate with case managers and medical, substance abuse, mental health and other social services
