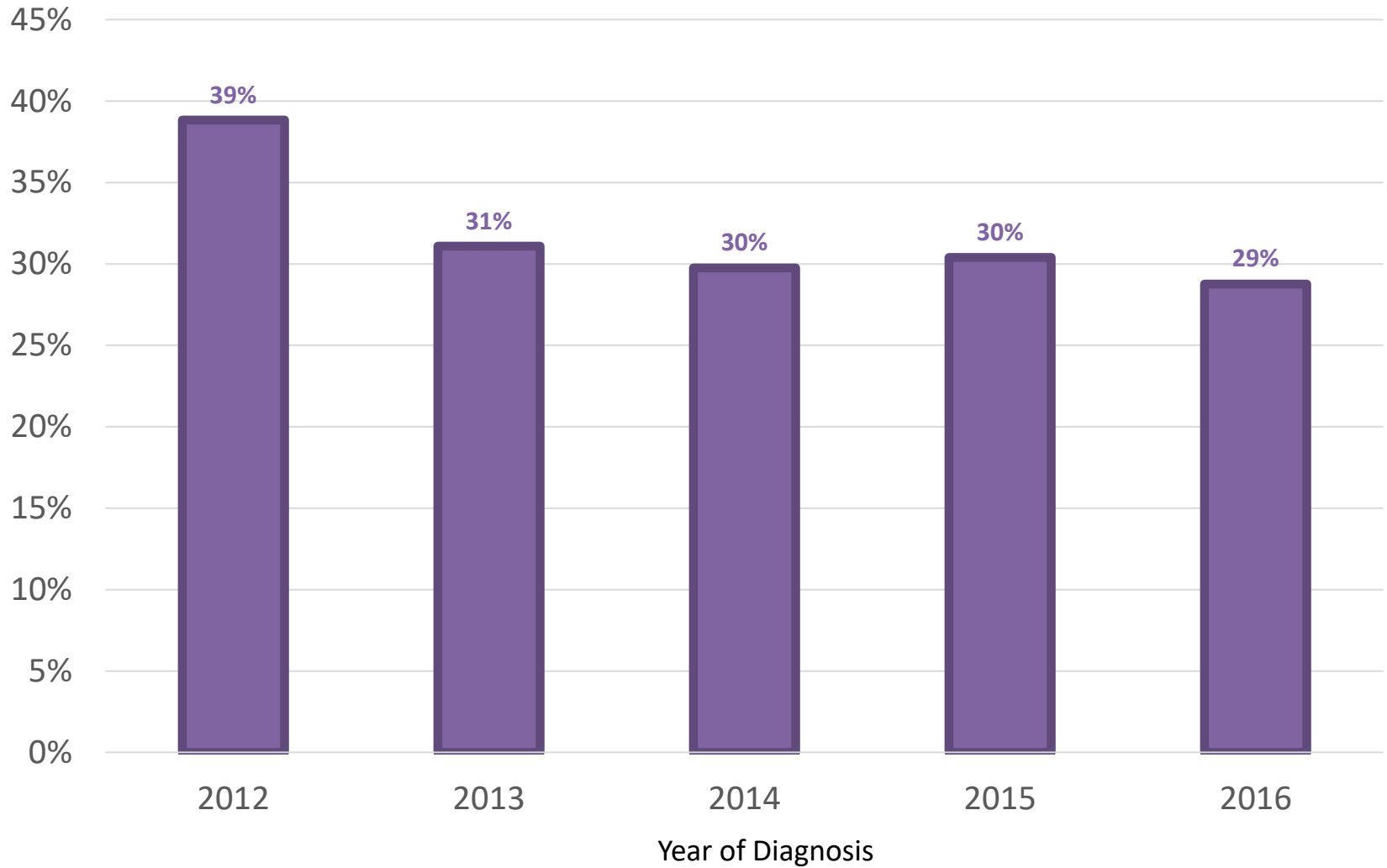
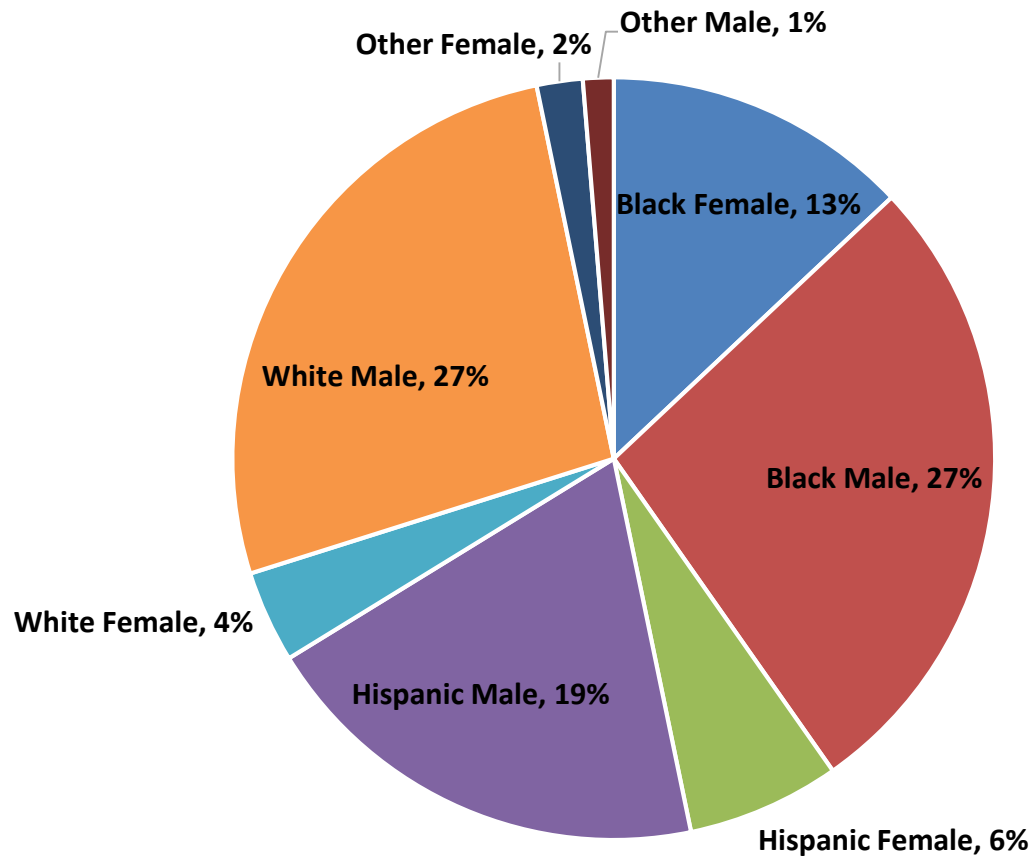


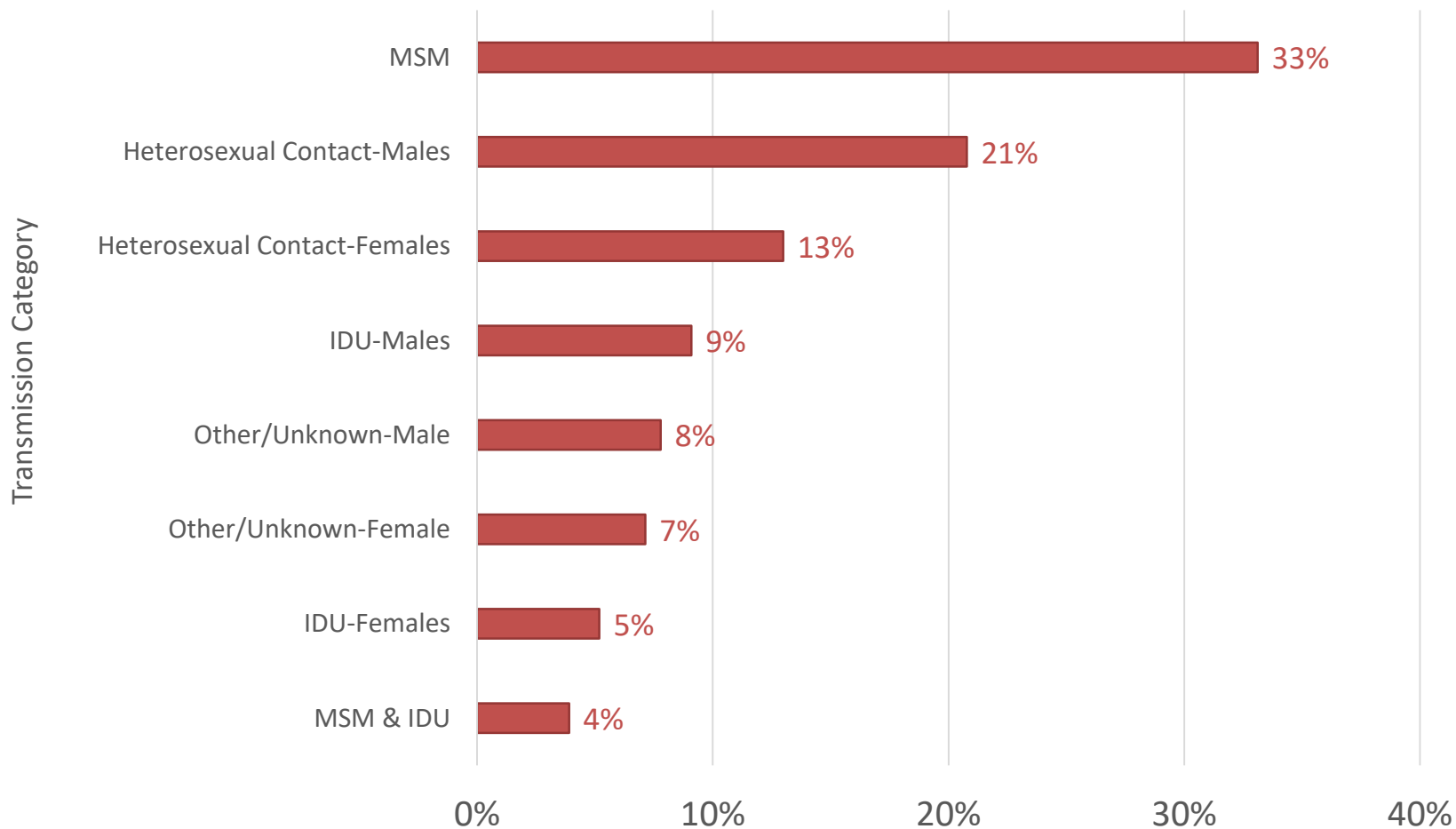

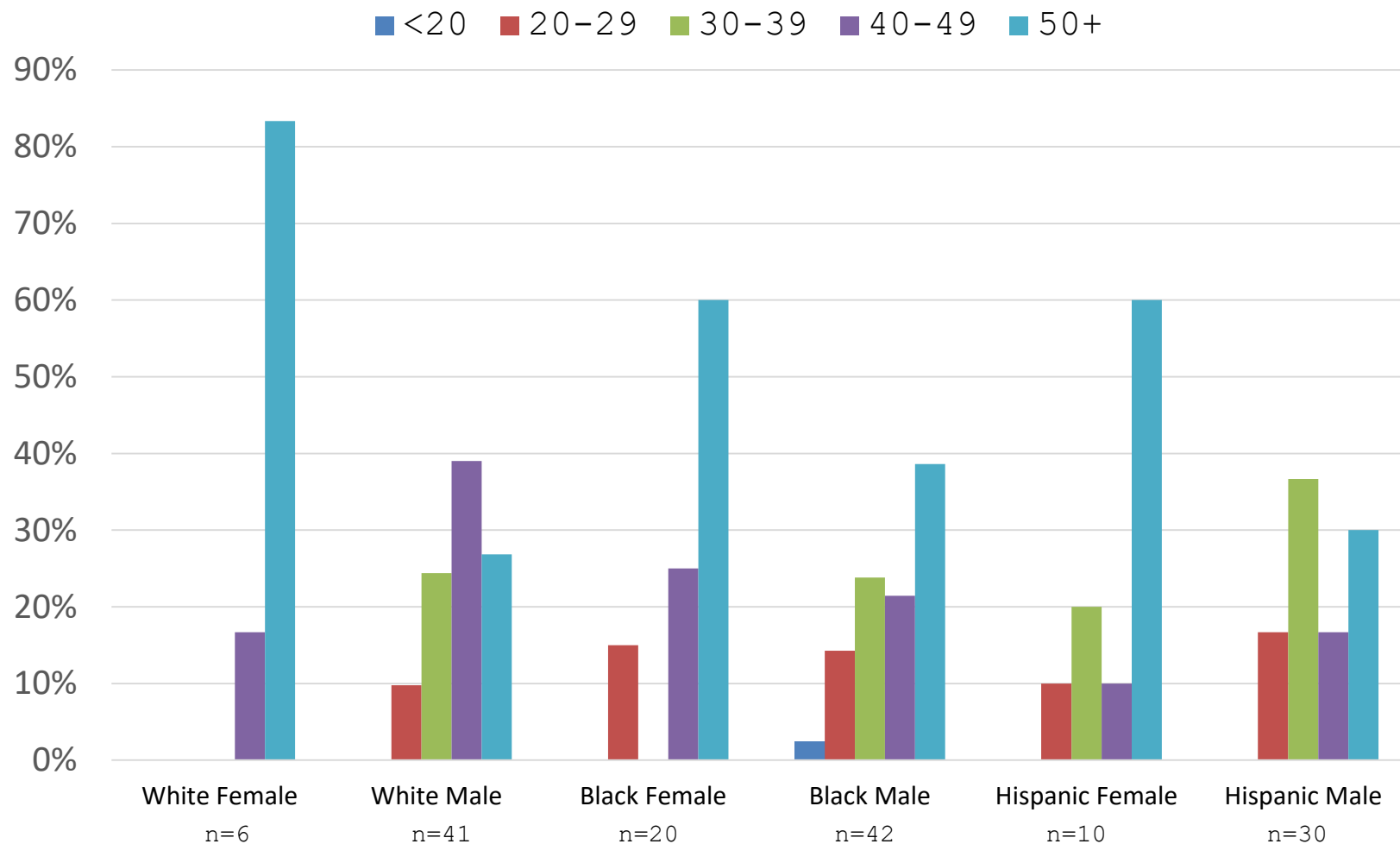

## “Late Testers”: AIDS at Initial Diagnosis or within 3 Months of HIV Diagnosis vs Others Diagnosed, Hartford TGA, 2012-2016

- Statistically significant difference between mean age ( $p < 0.05$ ) :
  - 44 years old (AIDS within 3 months)
  - 36 years old (for others)
- No statistically significant difference for sex nor race/ethnicity
